





Principles of Winemaking Course

Eligibility for the programme

- This programme is open to hospitality professionals who identify as Black, Asian, and ethnic minority.
- You must be 18 years or older to apply to this course.
- All applicants must be UK citizens, nationals, or permanent residents.
- A minimum of two years of experience working in the hospitality industry is required.
- No prior experience is required, though a genuine interest in winemaking and the factors influencing the style and quality of wine is essential.
- Mobility requirements or adjustments must be disclosed during the application process.
 Though not a barrier to accessing this course, it will help us plan and accommodate.

Application process

Applications are open until Friday 3rd May 2024

- Applicants will be notified by Tuesday 7th May whether they have been invited to video interviews. Interviews will be conducted between Wednesday 8th May and Monday 13th May.
- Successful applicants will be chosen by the Be Inclusive Hospitality team.
- Successful applicants will be notified by Wednesday 15th May 2023 at the latest and they will be required to sign an acceptance letter.
- The course will take place from Monday, 3rd June, until Friday, 7th June.

Further considerations

- This is not a position of employment, and the candidate will not be a Be Inclusive Hospitality employee.
- Be Inclusive Hospitality will cover the course cost, travel, and student accommodation (including meals).
- This accommodation, course and food costs will be paid directly to the course provider.







- Be Inclusive Hospitality is responsible for booking travel.
- The location of the college is Plumpton College, Ditchling Road, Lewes, BN7 3AE.
- Applicants should check that they are available on the course dates before applying.
- Courses are non-transferrable and cannot be exchanged for monetary value, voucher credit or transferred to another date.
- Courses must be taken by the applicant and cannot be gifted to another individual.
- Be Inclusive Hospitality, and Plumpton College reserve the right to withdraw places on the programme with a sufficient reason (such as absenteeism from the committed dates) and offer them to someone else where appropriate.

In return, the candidate will be expected to:

- Respect confidential information about Be Inclusive Hospitality or Plumpton College that it receives through the course and keep it confidential.
- Not bring Be Inclusive Hospitality or Plumpton College into disrepute.
- Commit to participating in photographs and content creation for Be Inclusive Hospitality's social platforms and websites.
