

WSET Level 2 & 3 in Wine

Eligibility for the Programme

- This programme is open to hospitality professionals who identify as Black, Asian, or from an ethnic minority background.
- You must be 18 years or older to apply.
- All applicants must be UK citizens, nationals, or permanent residents.
- A minimum of 18 months' experience working in the hospitality or drinks industry is required.
- You will benefit from attending WSET Level 1 before undertaking WSET Level 2.
- If you have already obtained Level 2, you must have achieved a minimum 70% pass grade to apply for WSET Level 3.
- Any mobility requirements or adjustments must be disclosed during the application process. While this will not be a barrier to accessing the course, it will help us plan and accommodate accordingly.

Application Process

- Applications are open until **Monday 14th April** at 5pm.
- Applicants will be notified by **Friday 18th April** if they have been invited for a video interview.
- Interviews will take place between **Monday 21st April and Friday 25th April**.
- Selection will be based on the strength of the application and interview.
- Successful applicants will be notified by **Wednesday 30th April** at the latest and will be required to sign an acceptance letter.
- *The course will take place on the following dates and is non-transferable:
 - WSET Level 2 in Wine – 3-Day Course (9:30 am – 5:30 pm)
Study Dates: Tuesday 10th, 17th & 24th June 2025
 - WSET Level 3 in Wine – 8-Day Course (9:30 am – 6:00 pm)
Study Dates: Thursday 4th, 18th, 25th September 2nd, 9th, 23rd October, and 6th November 2025
- *Please note that the dates are sometimes subject to change.

Further Considerations

- This is not an employment position, and candidates will not be employees of Be Inclusive Hospitality.
- Be Inclusive Hospitality or Bibendum Wine are not responsible for travel or other associated costs.
- The training will take place in London, and full details will be disclosed once confirmed.
- Applicants should ensure they are available on the course dates before applying.
- Courses are non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for monetary value, voucher credit, or rescheduled to another date.
- Courses must be attended by the applicant and cannot be gifted to another individual.
- Be Inclusive Hospitality and Bibendum Wine reserve the right to withdraw places on the programme for sufficient reasons (e.g. absenteeism from the committed dates) and offer them to another candidate if appropriate.
